

Apple Cyder's Napkin Ring Tutorial

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Fabric
Thread
Inkjet ready fabric sheets
9" x 1" slap bracelets

1. Print all the names that you would like to use on an inkjet ready fabric sheet. (Photo A.)

2. Cut out each individual name using pinking shears. {Pinking shears will help make sure that the fabric doesn't fray.}

3. Cut out a 11 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle of fabric.

4. Fold one of the short edges over ¼" and press.

5. Fold over ¼" again and press. (Photo B.)

6. Flip fabric rectangle over and topstitch so that you create one finished edge. (Photo C.)

7. Center the printed name tag on each rectangle and shift it by ¼" toward the finished edge in order to accommodate seam allowances. (Photo D.)

8. Stitch the name tag in place using a straight-stitch. {I only stitch the two short edges down, but you could stitch all the way around the name.}

9. With right sides together, fold the rectangle the long way and stitch around the bottom and side edges - $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. {Leave the finished edge open!} (Photo E.)

10. Zig-zag or overlock those same two edges, if desired.

11. Turn the napkin ring right-side-out and press, making sure that the seam is on the backside and the name is centered on the front. (Photo F.)

12. You will have to push the closed end of the napkin ring inside so that it makes a point. (Photo G.) Zig-zag the points together to close.

13. Slide slap bracelet inside.

14. Place folded napkin on your wrist.

15. Slap napkin ring around napkin. (Photo H.)

16. The napkin ring should look like this from the back. (Photo I.)
